Amendments proposed by House Committee on Judiciary to Original House Bill No. 358
by Representative Edmonds

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 10, after "justice" delete the remainder of the line and at the beginning of line
3 11, delete "created by the COVID-19 pandemic,"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, delete lines 18 through 20 and on page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert the
6 following:

7 "B. Pursuant to the inherent judicial power of the court, the court may
8 order the parties to any civil case to participate in the program. Any party
9 who wishes to opt out of the program shall file a written motion to opt out
10 within ten days after service of the order, which may be granted ex parte. If
11 no party opts out, all parties shall participate in the program unless a party
12 has been exempted by the court due to an undue hardship. An undue
13 hardship exists when a party cannot access the online system or participate
14 in the program without substantial difficulty or expense as determined by the
15 court."
