- 5 On page 1, delete lines 18 through 20 and on page 2, delete lines 1 and 2 and insert the
- 6 following:
- 7 "B. Pursuant to the inherent judicial power of the court, the court may order the parties to any civil case to participate in the program. Any party who wishes to 8 9 opt out of the program shall file a written motion to opt out within ten days after 10 service of the order, which may be granted ex parte. If no party opts out, all parties shall participate in the program unless a party has been exempted by the court due 11 to an undue hardship. An undue hardship exists when a party cannot access the 12 online system or participate in the program without substantial difficulty or expense 13
- 14 as determined by the court."
