**Abstract:** Provides relative to the payment of the bail obligation when the arrest occurs in a different jurisdiction from where the bail obligation originated.

Proposed law defines "originating jurisdiction" and "executing jurisdiction".

<u>Proposed law</u> allows a person who is arrested and booked in an executing jurisdiction pursuant to a warrant for arrest issued by the originating jurisdiction to post bail in either the originating or executing jurisdiction.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides the conditions by which <u>proposed law</u> may occur.

<u>Proposed law</u> specifies that <u>proposed law</u> is not applicable to warrants for sex offenses, homicides and crimes resulting in a death or deaths, felony domestic violence offenses, and aggravated offenses.
