## Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Makes technical changes.

## **Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate**

Present law allows for only one board officer to be compensated as an officer of the board.

Proposed law repeals this limitation.

<u>Present law</u> prohibits a member of the board of directors or of the credit or supervisory committees from receiving any compensation for his service as a member of the board or of the committee.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals this prohibition. <u>Proposed law</u> allows a credit union to reasonably compensate an officer, director, or committee member for his services to the credit union and also allows expense reimbursement for loss of pay and per diem.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the payment by the credit union of premiums for liability, travel, accident, hospitalization, or life insurance coverage is not considered compensation.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> in part, but changes hospitalization insurance to health insurance.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
