Amendments proposed by House Committee on Civil Law and Procedure to Original House Bill No. 103 by Representative McCormick

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 Delete House Committee Amendments by the House Committee on Civil Law and
3 Procedure (#2030)

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 1, line 2, after "relative to civil liability;" delete the remainder of the line and delete
6 line 3 in its entirety and on line 4, delete "public and private entities; to provide for
7 damages;" and insert the following:

8 "to provide for refusal to mandate COVID-19 vaccination; to provide relative to
9 business and professional licenses;"

10 AMENDMENT NO. 3

11 On page 1, delete lines 8 through 16 in their entirety, and insert the following:

12 "§2800.28. COVID-19 vaccination mandates; limitation of liability; protection of
13 business permits and professional licenses

14 A. No natural or juridical person shall be liable for any civil damages, and
15 no cause of action may be maintained against a natural or juridical person who, in
16 the course of, through the performance of, or by a provision of the person's business
17 operations, refuses to mandate a COVID-19 vaccination or immunization for any
18 employee or customer.

19 B. No state, state agency, or political subdivision of the state shall refuse to
20 permit, renew, or withhold a business license or professional license solely on the
21 basis that the business has refused to mandate a COVID-19 vaccination or
22 immunization for any employee or customer."
