## HOUSE COMMITTEE AMENDMENTS

Amendments proposed by House Committee on Appropriations to Engrossed House Bill No. 582 by Representative McFarland

- 1 AMENDMENT NO. 1
- On page 1, line 17, after "<u>levied</u>" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety and insert "<u>an</u>
  <u>annual road use fee of two hundred dollars per year</u>"
- 4 AMENDMENT NO. 2
- 5 On page 2, line 1, after "<u>levied</u>" delete the remainder of the line in its entirety and insert "<u>an</u> 6 annual road use fee of one hundred dollars per year on"
- 7 AMENDMENT NO. 3
- 8 On page 2, at the beginning of line 11, delete "<u>C. The</u>" and insert "<u>C.(1) The initial</u>"
- 9 AMENDMENT NO. 4
- 10 On page 2, line 12, after "sale" and before "of" insert "or lease"
- 11 AMENDMENT NO. 5
- 12 On page 2, at the end of line 15, insert the following:

## "The dealer shall indicate on the bill of sale or the lease agreement that the vehicle is an electric vehicle or a hybrid vehicle and shall provide a copy of the bill of sale or the lease agreement to the commissioner of motor vehicles. The commissioner of motor vehicles shall note the fuel type of these motor vehicles in order to track these vehicles for purposes of collecting the road use fee.

18 (2) Each year after the initial fee is imposed, no less than thirty days prior 19 to the anniversary date of the purchase or lease of the vehicle, the commissioner of 20 motor vehicles shall send written notice to the last known address of the registered 21 owner of the vehicle indicating the amount of the annual fee due and the deadline for 22 payment of the fee. All fees shall be due no later than thirty days from the date the 23 notice is mailed to the registered owner or lessee of the vehicle by the commissioner 24 of motor vehicles.

(3)(a) No later than January 1, 2022, the office of motor vehicles shall update
 forms related to the transfer of ownership of motor vehicles to include information
 regarding the fuel type of all motor vehicles required to be registered in this state.
 The requirements of this Paragraph shall apply to all transfers of ownership including
 sales by dealers, private sales of motor vehicles, and out of state transfers.

 <sup>30 (</sup>b) For all transfers of ownership of an electric vehicle or a hybrid vehicle,
 31 the office of motor vehicles shall comply with the provisions of Paragraph (2) of this
 32 Section."
