Present law requires the treasurer to annually publish a notice regarding any abandoned property that has been paid or delivered to the treasurer in the previous year. Among other requirements, the notice must include the name and last known address of the apparent owner.

Proposed law retains present law.

Proposed law exempts from the Public Records Law the specific monetary value and name of the company that remitted assets held by the state pursuant to the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act of 1997, except as otherwise provided by present law.

Proposed law exempts from the Public Records Law personally identifiable information of claimants of property held by the state pursuant to the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act of 1997, except as otherwise provided by present law. Provides, however, that proposed law shall not prevent a judgment creditor or a person who can demonstrate entitlement to the property from obtaining the information regarding a claimant of property through a public records request.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by Senate

Committee Amendments Proposed by Senate Committee on Senate and Governmental Affairs to the original bill

1. Exempts the specific monetary value and name of the company that remitted assets held in the state treasury from the Public Records Law.

Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

The Committee Amendments Proposed by House Committee on House and Governmental Affairs to the engrossed bill:

1. Provide that a judgment creditor or person who can demonstrate entitlement may obtain a claimant's information through a public records request.
