5 AMENDMENT NO. 13

6 On page 22, line 15, after "R.S. 49:953(A)" delete "prior to December 2, 2021." and insert
7 "no later than six months after this Act becomes effective in accordance with Section 5 of
8 this Act."

9 AMENDMENT NO. 14

10 On page 22, delete lines 19 through 21 in their entirety and insert the following:

11 "Section 5. This Act shall become effective if and when 21 U.S.C. §812 is
12 amended and marijuana is removed from Schedule I of the Controlled Dangerous
13 Substance Law or R.S. 40:966 is amended and marijuana and tetrahydrocannabinols
14 are removed from Schedule I of the Uniform Controlled Dangerous Substances
15 Law."
