CURRICULA: Removes the termination of the Dual Enrollment Framework Task Force

DIGEST

<u>Present law</u> establishes the Dual Enrollment Framework Task Force to make recommendations for a statewide dual enrollment framework to provide universal access to dual enrollment courses. Requires local public school boards to develop agreements with colleges and universities for articulation and transfer of credit.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law provides for task force termination on June 30, 2021.

<u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u> provisions relative to termination date. Further provides that the task force is responsible for implementing the dual enrollment framework.

<u>Proposed law</u> adds one member to the task force who is a secondary school teacher who teaches a dual enrollment course.

<u>Present law</u> provided for a written report to the education committees of the legislature by October 1, 2020.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires an annual written report to the education committees of the legislature sixty days prior to the regular legislative session.
