Amendments proposed by Representative Wright to Engrossed House Bill No. 633 by Representative Wright

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, at the beginning of line 7, delete "32:667(K)" and insert "32:667(B)(3)(d) and
3 (K)"

4 AMENDMENT NO. 2

5 On page 7, line 19, after the comma "," and before "or" change "three" to "four"

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 13, delete line 22 in its entirety and insert "Program (SNAP), Medicaid, social
8 security disability insurance (SSDI) or supplemental security income (SSI) administered by
9 the social security administration."

10 AMENDMENT NO. 4

11 On page 14, at the beginning of line 9, delete "Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program
12 (SNAP) or" and insert "SNAP," and after "Medicaid" and before the period "." insert ", SSDI
13 or SSI administered by the social security administration"

14 AMENDMENT NO. 5

15 On page 14, line 13, after "SNAP" and before "Medicaid" delete "or" and insert a comma
16 "," and after "Medicaid" and before "on" insert ", SSDI, or SSI"

17 AMENDMENT NO. 6

18 On page 15, line 6, after "reenacted and" and before "hereby" delete "R.S. 32:667(K) is" and
19 insert "R.S. 32:667(B)(3)(d) and (K) are"

20 AMENDMENT NO. 7

21 On page 16, line 21, after the comma "," and before "or" change "three" to "four"

22 AMENDMENT NO. 8

23 On page 20, between lines 11 and 12, insert the following:

24 "(d) If the person refused the test as a result of a first violation, he shall be
25 eligible for a hardship license during the entire period of the imposed one-year
26 suspension after he has provided proof that his motor vehicle has been equipped with
27 an ignition interlock device. A functioning ignition interlock device shall remain
28 installed on his motor vehicle during the entire period of his driver's license
29 suspension. A person subject to this Subparagraph may have the ignition interlock
30 device removed two hundred and seventy days after installation if there have been
31 no violation resets or permanent lockouts pursuant to R.S. 15:307(C)."
