

1 WHEREAS, the 2021 Federal American Rescue Plan provides preferential treatment
2 to a portion of the \$1.9 trillion to residents in states that have adopted the UHPA; and

3 WHEREAS, eighteen states have adopted the UHPA since 2011 and seven states,
4 including North Carolina and the District of Colombia, have legislation pending to adopt
5 UHPA during this 2021 legislative session; and

6 WHEREAS, our neighboring and southern states of Alabama, Mississippi, Arkansas,
7 Georgia, South Carolina, Virginia, Florida, and Texas have adopted the UHPA.

8 THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby
9 direct the Louisiana State Law Institute to study provisions of law in order to make
10 recommendations regarding adoption of the UHPA, and to report its findings and
11 recommendations to the Louisiana Legislature no later than February 1, 2022.

12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislature of Louisiana does hereby direct
13 the Louisiana State Law Institute to invite participation from representatives of the Louisiana
14 Realtors Association, the Louisiana Appleseed Center for Law and Justice, the Louisiana
15 Land Title Association, the Louisiana Association of Independent Land Title Agents, the
16 Uniform Law Commission, and the Louisiana Banker's Association.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that a copy of this Resolution be transmitted to the
18 director of the Louisiana State Law Institute.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Louisiana State Law Institute shall submit
20 one print copy and one electronic copy of any report produced pursuant to this Resolution
21 to the David R. Poynter Legislative Research Library as required by R.S. 24:772.
