Amendments proposed by Senate Committee on Judiciary A to Reengrossed House Bill No. 159 by Representative White

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, line 12, change “1002(A)(2)(a)” to “1002(A)(2)”

3 AMENDMENT NO. 2

4 On page 2, line 10, after “and 162,” and before “and to repeal” insert “and R.S.
5 46:2136.3(A)(3).”

6 AMENDMENT NO. 3

7 On page 15, line 12, change “1002(A)(2)(a)” to “1002(A)(2)”

8 AMENDMENT NO. 4

9 On page 20, delete line 4 in its entirety and insert the following:

10 "of Civil Procedure Article 3607.1, or Articles 30, 320, or 871.1 of this Code that
11 meets the requirements set forth in R.S. 46:2136.3.

12 (b) The issuance of a Uniform Abuse Prevention Order, either after a consent
13 agreement between the parties or after reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard
14 was given to the person against whom the order was sought sufficient to protect that
15 person's right to due process, that includes terms that prohibit the person from
16 possessing a firearm or carrying a concealed weapon and that meets the requirements
17 set forth in R.S. 46:2136.3."

18 AMENDMENT NO. 5

19 On page 48, line 12, after “reenacted” and before “to read as follows:” insert “and R.S.
20 46:2136.3(A)(3) is hereby enacted”

21 AMENDMENT NO. 6

22 On page 58, line 12, change “both” to “all”

23 AMENDMENT NO. 7

24 On page 58, between lines 13 and 14, insert the following:

25 “(3) The permanent injunction or protective order was issued either after a consent
26 agreement between the parties or after reasonable notice and opportunity to be heard was
27 given to the person against whom the order was sought sufficient to protect that person’s
28 right to due process.”
