- A. There is hereby created in the state treasury, as a special fund, the Louisiana Tourism Revival Fund, hereinafter referred to in this Section as the "fund". The treasurer is
- 31 hereby authorized and directed to transfer seventy-seven million five-hundred thousand
- dollars from the Louisiana Rescue Plan Fund into the fund.
- B. All unexpended and unencumbered monies in the fund at the end of the fiscal year shall remain in the fund. Monies in the fund shall be invested in the same manner as monies in the state general fund. Interest earned on the investment of monies in the fund
- shall be deposited in and credited to the fund.
- C. Monies in the fund shall be utilized to support the efforts of the state, local, and
   regional tourism entities to revive the tourism in Louisiana by investing in programs focused
- 39 on marketing and promoting Louisiana as a destination for in-state and out-of-state travel activity.
- D. Monies in the fund shall be distributed as follows: sixty million dollars shall be used for the Louisiana Tourism Revival Program as provided for in R.S. 39:100.55.2 and

- seventeen million five-hundred thousand dollars shall be appropriated to the Department of
   Culture, Recreation and Tourism for the Marketing Program.
- 3 <u>§100.55.2. Louisiana Tourism Industry Revival Program</u>
  4 A. The Louisiana Tourism Industry Revival Program
  - A. The Louisiana Tourism Industry Revival Program is established to provide grants to local and regional tourist commissions for marketing and promoting Louisiana as a tourism destination for in-state and out-of-state travel activity. The GOHSEP shall administer the program.
  - B. The division of administration shall establish a program portal in which applications shall be submitted and the division shall publish information on the program. The program portal page shall be operational no later than August 31, 2021.
- 11 <u>C. In order to qualify to receive a grant award, the tourist commission must be</u> 12 formed and created pursuant to R.S. 33:4574.
- D. The division of administration shall submit a plan for the administration and structure of the program to the Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget by July 31, 2021 for review and approval at the monthly August meeting. No grants shall be awarded prior to Joint Legislative Committee on the Budget approving the plan submitted by the division of administration."

  - B.(1) The Water Sector Commission is hereby created and established to provide recommendations for grant funding for repairs, improvements, and consolidation of community water and sewer systems, and repairs and improvements necessitated by storm water, made possible by the American Rescue Plan Act. The Commission shall be responsible for developing and directing the Water Sector Program.
  - (2) The Commission shall be comprised of ten members, five members appointed by the President of the Senate and five members appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives. A Senate member of the Commission and a House member of the Commission shall serve as co-chairmen of the Commission. A quorum of the Commission shall be six members.
  - C.(1) The Commission shall develop the guidance and recommendations for the distribution of grants from the Water Sector Fund, the monies in which fund were received by the state pursuant to the American Rescue Plan Act.
  - (2)(a) The Commission shall meet no later than July 14, 2021, to adopt the guidance, a recommendation process, and eligibility criteria for community water systems, community sewer systems, and local governing authorities to participate in the program. Such guidance, recommendations, and criteria shall include, but not be limited to, the following:
  - (i) Application requirements;
    - (ii) A time line for application submissions and approval;
- 49 (iii) Criteria for ratings;
- 50 (iv) A process for prioritizing critical infrastructure needs; and
- 51 (v) Requirements for matching funds, waivers of matching funds or decreasing the match requirement.

1	(b) The guidance, recommendation process, and eligibility criteria shall be
2	completed and published on the division of administration's program portal page in
3	adequate time as to allow the program to commence no later than August 1, 2021.
4	D.(1) The Commission shall establish the direction and responsibilities of a
5 6	working panel of professionals from the following offices: the office of public health in the Louisiana Department of Health, the office of community development in the
7	division of administration, the office of facility planning and control in the division
8	of administration, and the Department of Environmental Quality, hereinafter referred
9	to as the "working panel".
10	(2) The office of facility planning and control and the division of
11	administration shall be responsible for administering the program and establishing
12	the program portal page in which applications shall be submitted.
13	(3) The Commission shall submit the adopted guidance, recommendations,
14	and eligible criteria to the division of administration to be published on the program's
15	portal page maintained by the division of administration. The program portal page
16 17	shall be operational no later than August 1, 2021.  E.(1) The working panel shall assist the Subcommittee in its work and furnish
18	such information, reports, aid, services, and assistance as may be requested by the
19	Commission.
20	(2) The working panel shall review and rate applications submitted by
21	community water systems, community sewer systems, and local governing
22	authorities. The working panel shall make recommendations in accordance with the
23	guidance established by the Commission.
24	(3) In recommending a process for prioritizing critical infrastructure needs,
25	the working panel shall consider such factors as the condition of the system, the
26	system's or local governing authority's available resources, and the other funding
27	sources available to the system or local governing authority.
28	F. Interested participants shall apply through the division of administration's
29 30	<u>program portal page.</u> G. No later than seven business days after the program portal page receives
31	applications, the working panel shall begin processing and reviewing applications.
32	All applications shall include the following, at a minimum:
33	(1) The amount of grant funding requested.
34	(2) The current condition of the system and the proposed use of the grant
35	funding.
36	(3) The amount and proposed source of funding for a required match.
37	(4) Proposals for repairs, improvements, or consolidation with neighboring
38	systems.  (5) Proposals for any min a the financial system shifts and compliance of the
39 40	(5) Proposals for ensuring the financial sustainability and compliance of the
40 41	systems, including proposals for increasing rates paid by users of the system based on a fair assessment of the system to comparable systems.
42	H. The working panel shall make recommendations every fifteen days to the
43	Commission. Recommendations to the Commission shall include:
44	(1) Recommendations for utilization of existing resources including the
45	Drinking Water Revolving Loan Fund, Clean Water State Revolving Fund, and
46	Community Water Enrichment and Other Improvements Fund.
47	(2) Certification that the local governing authority that operates the system
48	either utilized funding received pursuant to the Coronavirus Local Fiscal Recovery
49	Fund of the American Rescue Act Plan of 2021 as the source of funding for the
50	required match or had legitimate cause that precluded the use of those funds for the
51	match.  (2) The Commission shall make recommendations to the Committee event.
52 53	(3) The Commission shall make recommendations to the Committee every month until all funds are expended or obligated.
54	I. No money shall be expended from the program without the approval of the
55	Committee.
56	J. The provisions of R.S. 39:72.1(A) shall not apply to monies appropriated
57	from the fund pursuant to this Section.
58	K. If a community water system, community sewer system or a local
59	governing authority has received or is on the list to receive a line of credit pursuant
60	to the Act which originated as House Bill Number 2 of the 2021 Regular Session of
