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HCR 89 Engrossed 2021 Regular Session Marcelle

Requests the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and the La. Sheriffs' Association, in conjunction with technical and research assistance from the Lyndon B. Johnson School of Public Affairs at the University of Texas at Austin, to study and review models for oversight, transparency, and accountability adopted in other states and provide recommendations through a report of their findings to the legislature no later than Sept. 1, 2022.

## Summary of Amendments Adopted by House

- The Committee Amendments Proposed by <u>House Committee on Administration of Criminal</u> <u>Justice to the original bill:</u>
- 1. Remove Voice of the Experienced, Loyola University College of Law, and La. Stop Solitary Confinement Coalition and request that the study be conducted by the Dept. of Public Safety and Corrections and the La. Sheriffs' Association.
- 2. Change the deadline to report findings to the legislature from Feb. 1, 2022, to Sept. 1, 2022.
- 3. Rephrase the statements supporting the study request.
