1 A RESOLUTION

2 To commend Bossier Parish Community College for its achievements.

3 WHEREAS, Bossier Parish Community College had a truly impressive year and  
4 accomplished a number of noteworthy achievements; and

5 WHEREAS, the Bossier Parish Community College athletic program was incredibly  
6 successful this year and all teams competed in post-season competitions; the softball team  
7 had a record-setting season and finished as the regular season champions of their conference;  
8 the track and field team also had its first ever nationals-qualifying athletes; and

9 WHEREAS, the debate team won the national debate championship for the fifth time  
10 in school history; and

11 WHEREAS, the Bossier Parish Community College Nursing Program faculty and  
12 students participated in extensive volunteer efforts to support COVID-19 testing and  
13 vaccinations over the course of the past year; the program also enjoyed a 100% passage rate  
14 for first-time NCLEX-RN exam takers; and

15 WHEREAS, Bossier Parish Community College also had its first Fulbright Scholar-  
16 in-Residence; the student is a native of Belize and is also the first Fulbright Scholar-in-  
17 Residence for any two-year college in Louisiana; and

18 WHEREAS, 2021 was the tenth-consecutive year that the school was recognized as  
19 a military-friendly college; it is also recognized as a military spouse-friendly college; and

1           WHEREAS, the Bossier Parish Community College's Cavalier Care Center opened  
2 this year to serve as a clearing house for student support services that address insecurities  
3 that impact student success; and

4           WHEREAS, Bossier Parish Community College received the 2021 Top Business  
5 Innovation Award from the Shreveport Chamber of Commerce and was a finalist for the  
6 2021 Bellwether Award; and

7           WHEREAS, Bossier Parish Community College also collaborated with Northwest  
8 Louisiana Technical Community College to offer a new commercial vehicle operations  
9 program, and the school is launching new programs to meet regional workforce needs; and

10          WHEREAS, Bossier Parish Community College is most deserving of recognition for  
11 having a truly outstanding year filled with accomplishments and accolades.

12          THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the House of Representatives of the  
13 Legislature of Louisiana does hereby commend Bossier Parish Community College for its  
14 achievements; does hereby recognize Bossier Parish Community College's immense value  
15 to the state of Louisiana as an institution of higher education; and does hereby extend sincere  
16 hopes that Bossier Parish Community College enjoy success in its future endeavors.
