CURRICULA: Removes the termination of the Dual Enrollment Framework Task Force

Synopsis of Senate Amendments

1. Require the Bd. of Regents to submit an annual report to the legislature.

Digest of Bill as Finally Passed by Senate

Present law establishes the Dual Enrollment Framework Task Force to make recommendations for a statewide dual enrollment framework to provide universal access to dual enrollment courses. Requires local public school boards to develop agreements with colleges and universities for articulation and transfer of credit. Proposed law retains present law.

Present law provides for task force termination on June 30, 2021. Proposed law repeals present law. Further provides that the task force is responsible for implementing the dual enrollment framework.

Present law requires the Bd. of Regents to submit a written report of task force findings and recommendations to the legislative committees on education by Oct. 1, 2020. Proposed law requires annual submission of such a report.

Proposed law adds one member to the task force who is a secondary school teacher who teaches a dual enrollment course.
