A RESOLUTION

To commend the Bossier Parish Community College nursing program.

WHEREAS, the Bossier Parish Community College (BPCC) nursing program is committed to student-centered learning through academic instruction, clinical simulation, clinical experiences, and community service to promote excellence in nursing; and

WHEREAS, BPCC recognizes the nursing faculty and students for their extensive volunteerism to support COVID testing and vaccinations and boasts a 100% passage rate for first-time takers of the National Council Licensure Examination - Registered Nurse (NCLEX-RN) for its graduates; and

WHEREAS, BPCC is launching a new Licensed Practical Nursing program this year to meet regional workforce needs; and

WHEREAS, nursing is a high demand career with good employment opportunities and job stability; many hospitals may offer new graduates incentives, such as sign-on bonuses, shift differentials, or tuition reimbursement; and
