5 generation roper and has competed her whole life; and

6 WHEREAS, growing up on the family farm in Welsh, Louisiana, Sydnie has been  
7 inspired to pursue her rodeo dreams as she follows in the footsteps of her mother and  
8 competes with the horses bred and trained by her family; and

9 WHEREAS, Sydnie, as a thirteen-year-old eighth-grader, had success in the National  
10 Little Britches Rodeo Association (NLBRA) when she placed sixth in the world in  
11 breakaway roping and won two all-around titles in a local junior rodeo association; and

12 WHEREAS, currently Sydnie is a home schooled sophomore who enjoys English  
13 and writing and is a member of the Louisiana High School Rodeo Association; and

14 WHEREAS, this impressive fifteen-year-old has placed in the following roping  
15 events: RFD-The American 3rd place in Breakaway Roping; AT&T Top 8 Round in 3rd  
16 place; AT&T Top 16 Round in 1st place; Top 30 - 3rd place; and in the Semi-finals averaged
