**KEYWORD AND SUMMARY AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE**

VOTERS/VOTING. Requires certain absentee ballots to be delivered to the registrar or an employee of the registrar of voters

**SUMMARY OF HOUSE AMENDMENTS TO THE SENATE BILL**

1. Removes mobiles registration unit from locations where ballots can be hand delivered.
2. Provides that hand delivery of the ballot may be to the registrar of an employee of the registrar.

**DIGEST OF THE SENATE BILL AS RETURNED TO THE SENATE**

Present law requires an absentee by mail ballot to be marked as provided in present law and returned to the registrar by the United States Postal Service, a commercial courier, or hand-delivery.

Proposed law retains the delivery methods in present law and requires a hand-delivered absentee by mail ballot to be returned to the registrar or an employee of the registrar at the registrar's principal office, branch office, or early voting location during the period for early voting.

Effective upon signature of governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
