<u>Present law</u> provides for the Department of Environmental Quality to charge certain fees. <u>Proposed law</u> provides for additional fees that the secretary may assess, including an annual fee for dependent mobile laboratories, accreditation fees for in state and out-of-state laboratories receiving national accreditation, accreditation fees for out-of-state laboratories receiving state accreditation, and interim accreditation application fees.

Proposed law authorizes increases in air fees, solid waste fees, and waste tire fees.

Proposed law authorizes the secretary to establish and increase fees associated with radiation protection.

EXPENDITURE EXPLANATION

There is no anticipated direct material effect on governmental expenditures as a result of this measure.

REVENUE EXPLANATION

<u>Proposed law</u> will increase revenues generated from various new fees in the Department of Environmental Quality's (DEQ) Environmental Trust Dedicated Fund Account beginning in FY 23. <u>Proposed law</u> increases the criteria pollutant annual fee in two phases. Phase 1 increases fees to \$16.61 per ton in FY 23. Phase 2 increases fees to \$20 per ton in FY 24. DEQ estimates that the total revenue increase will be \$2.3 M in FY 23 and \$2.9 M in FY 24 and in the out years, based on current data. The Fund Account provides for general operating expenditures of the the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ) as enumerated in LA R.S. 30:2015. The table below reports the revenue impact for FY 23.


