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COURTS EN NO IMPACT LF EX See Note Provides relative to the Online Judge Pilot Program

Proposed law authorizes the 24th Judicial District (JDC) to establish an Online Judge Pilot Program in an effort to improve access to justice and create a more efficient and effective justice system. Proposed law provides that the court may order the parties in any civil case to participate in the program, with the option to opt out upon filing a written motion within ten days after service of the order. Proposed law defines undue hardship with regard to participation. The program shall expire on August 1, 2025.
