Present law provided for the licensing and regulation of marine products by the La. Motor Vehicle Commission.

Prior law defined "marine product" as a new or used watercraft, boat, marine motor, and a boat or watercraft trailer. Provided an exclusion for watercraft designed for use primarily for commercial or governmental purposes or a new or used watercraft or boat adapted to be powered only by the occupant's energy.

New law adds an exclusion to the definition of "marine product" for a marine motor used primarily for commercial or governmental purposes.

New law provides that the prior law exclusion for a watercraft will apply only if the watercraft is used primarily for commercial or governmental purposes.

Effective August 1, 2021.
