

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**SR 195**

**2021 Regular Session**

**Cloud**

Requests the office of attorney general to reestablish the Task Force on Protecting Children from Exposure to Pornography to continue its study of all issues related to the exposure of children to, and the impact it has, on their lives. Requires report to the Senate no later than January 1, 2022, at which time the task force shall cease to exist.

Provides that the task force be comprised of the following members:

- (1) The president pro tempore of the Senate, or her designee.
- (2) The chair of the Senate Select Committee on Women and Children, or her designee.
- (3) The secretary of the Department of Children and Family Services, or his designee.
- (4) A member of the Governor's Advisory Board of Juvenile Justice and Delinquency Prevention, appointed by the governor.
- (5) The chairman of the La. Cybersecurity Commission, or his designee.
- (6) The chairman of the Children's Code Committee of the La. State Law Institute, or his designee.
- (7) The president of the La. District Attorneys Association, or his designee.
- (8) A representative of the attorney general's Cyber Crime Unit, appointed by the attorney general.
- (9) The state superintendent of education, or his designee.
- (10) The executive director of the La. Baptist Convention, or his designee.
- (11) The executive director of the La. Conference of Catholic Bishops, or his designee.
- (12) The president of the La. Family Forum, or his designee.
- (13) The board chair of the La. Partnership for Children and Families, or his designee.
- (14) The chief executive officer of the La. Cable and Telecommunications Association – The Internet & Television Association, or his designee.
- (15) The president of the La. Telecommunications Association, or his designee.
