For purposes of this Section, "Class C-Package Store" shall be defined as 11 an establishment that meets all of the following: 12 13 (7) Does not allow the consumption of any alcoholic beverage for any 14 purpose or reason on or about the licensed establishment unless and except as 15 otherwise provided for in this Title. Operates a package store whereby the primary 16 sales of alcoholic beverages at the location are sales of factory-sealed containers for 17 off-premise consumption. However, the retailer may sell alcoholic beverages for on-18 premise consumption not to exceed twenty percent of the business's annual revenue 19 of alcoholic beverage sales.
