<u>Prior law</u> required the treasurer to annually publish a notice regarding any abandoned property that has been paid or delivered to the treasurer in the previous year. Among other requirements, the notice must include the name and last known address of the apparent owner.

<u>New law</u> retains prior law.

<u>New law</u> exempts from the Public Records Law the specific monetary value and name of the company that remitted assets held by the state pursuant to the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act of 1997, except as otherwise provided by <u>prior law</u>.

<u>New law</u> exempts from the Public Records Law personally identifiable information of claimants of property held by the state pursuant to the Uniform Unclaimed Property Act of 1997, except as otherwise provided by <u>prior law</u>. <u>New law</u> shall not prevent a judgment creditor or a person who can demonstrate entitlement to the property from obtaining the name and address of a claimant of property through a public records request.

Effective August 1, 2021.
