New law defines "originating jurisdiction" and "executing jurisdiction".

<u>New law</u> allows a person who is arrested and booked in an executing jurisdiction pursuant to a warrant for arrest issued by the originating jurisdiction to post bail in either the originating or executing jurisdiction.

New law provides the conditions by which new law may occur.

<u>New law</u> specifies that <u>new law</u> is not applicable to warrants for sex offenses, homicides and crimes resulting in a death or deaths, felony domestic violence offenses, and aggravated offenses.

Effective August 1, 2021.
