## ACT 235 (HB 406) 2021 Regular Session

Bishop

Existing law authorizes the court to permit a defendant charged with a misdemeanor to be arraigned, enter his plea of guilty, or be tried in his absence.

<u>Prior law</u> authorized a plea of not guilty of a misdemeanor to be entered through counsel and in the absence of the defendant.

<u>New law</u> provides that pleas of not guilty of misdemeanors shall be entered through counsel of record and in the absence of the defendant by the filing of a sworn affidavit in advance of the scheduled arraignment date.

<u>New law</u> requires and provides the form counsel is to use when accepting service and waiving the presence of the defendant.

Effective August 1, 2021.
