

## RÉSUMÉ DIGEST

**ACT 305 (HB 316)**

**2021 Regular Session**

**Davis**

Existing law provides that a physician attending to the care of a newborn child shall cause the child to be subjected to tests for certain genetic conditions provided for in existing law that have been approved by the La. Dept. of Health. Further provides that such tests shall be given to any child whose parents object to the testing.

New law adds the following to the list provided therein of genetic conditions for which newborns shall be tested:

- (1) Mucopolysaccharidosis type I (MPS I)
- (2) Glycogen storage disorder type II (Pompe disease)

New law supersedes amendments made to existing law R.S. 40:1081.2(A)(1) by §1 of Act No. 507 of the 2016 Regular Session.

Effective January 1, 2022.
