Existing law provides for testing public school students for dyslexia.

New law requires public school governing authorities to report to the state Dept. of Education relative to certain groups of students identified as having dyslexia, disaggregated by grade and type of education plan, by Oct. 31st annually. Requires the department to submit a cumulative report to the legislative education committees by Dec. 1st annually.

Effective August 1, 2021.
