Existing law establishes a Capital Area Groundwater Conservation District and its board of commissioners.

<u>Existing law</u> authorizes the board of commissioners to assess a charge against all users within the district based on units of water used.

<u>New law grants the board the additional authority to assess costs for capital expenditures, late fees for nonpayment, and application fees.</u>

<u>New law</u> further provides what may constitute costs for capital expenditures and establishes limits for how much the board can charge users for late fees (up to \$25 per month or 1 & $\frac{1}{2}$ percent per day or balance due) and application fees (up to \$2000 per submitted application).

Effective August 1, 2021.
