Abstract: Excludes the admissibility of any information in a criminal proceeding that law enforcement agencies obtain through deceptive practices.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that any information obtained in an investigation by means of misrepresentation or deceptive practices by any law enforcement agency or investigator shall not be admissible in any criminal proceeding.

<u>Proposed law</u> defines "deceptive practices" as the act, use, or employment of any fraud, false pretense, false promise, or misleading statement by any law enforcement agency, officer, or investigator, with the intent that an individual reasonably believes the information to be true in connection to a criminal investigation.

<u>Proposed law</u> does not apply to any information obtained by any law enforcement agency, officer, or investigator engaged in an authorized undercover investigation.
