SUPPLEMENTAL PAY: Provides relative to supplemental pay for tribal officers of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of Louisiana

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 40:1667.1(F)(2), relative to supplemental pay for tribal officers
3	of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of Louisiana; to increase the number of tribal officers
4	eligible for supplemental pay; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 40:1667.1(F)(2) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
7	§1667.1. Rate of compensation; prior service; supplemental monthly compensation;
8	police to receive additional compensation

12	(2) Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary, the
13	compensation for tribal officers of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of Louisiana shall be for

Abstract: Increases the number of tribal officers of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of La. that are eligible for supplemental pay <u>from</u> 13 to 20.

<u>Present law</u> provides for supplemental pay of \$500 per month for any full-time police officer paid by any municipality or by the Chitimacha Tribe of La., Coushatta Tribe of La., or the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe of La. that has passed a council-certified training program and completed one year of service.

<u>Present law</u> limits the number of tribal officers from the Chitimacha Tribe, Coushatta Tribe, and the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe that are eligible for supplemental pay.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the number of eligible tribal officers of the Tunica-Biloxi Tribe $\underline{\text{from}}$ 13 $\underline{\text{to}}$ 20.
