2	To enact R.S. 23:1310.5.1, relative to workers' compensation; to provide for continuances
3	in mediations, hearings and trials; to require the granting of continuances under
4	certain circumstances; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 23:1310.5.1 is hereby enacted to read as follows:
7	<u>§1310.5.1. Continuances</u>
8	If the parties, whether represented or unrepresented, agree to a continuance
9	of a mediation, hearing, or trial by filing a joint motion to continue or an uncontested
10	motion to continue, the workers' compensation judge shall grant the continuance.
