Amendments proposed by House Committee on Administration of Criminal Justice to
Original House Bill No. 102 by Representative Muscarello

1 AMENDMENT NO. 1

2 On page 1, delete lines 17 through 20 in their entirety and insert the following:

3 "committee shall not consider a parole rehearing of any prisoner who is serving a
4 sentence for any of the following offenses until at least four years after the denial of
5 parole:

6 (i) Any crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2(B) or sex offense as
7 defined in R.S. 15:541, for which the prisoner is serving a life sentence and for
8 which the prisoner is eligible for parole pursuant to any of the provisions of R.S.
9 15:574.4.

10 (ii) Any crime that is both a crime of violence as defined in R.S. 14:2(B) and
11 a sex offense as defined in R.S. 15:541, for which the prisoner is serving a fixed term
12 of years and for which the prisoner is eligible for parole pursuant to any of the
13 provisions of R.S. 15:574.4.

14 (iii) Manslaughter (R.S. 14:31), for which the prisoner is eligible for parole
15 pursuant to any of the provisions of R.S. 15:574.4."
