Abstract: Provides a limited exception to the general licensing requirement for persons installing generator gas lines.

<u>Present law</u> requires a person engaging in the work of a gas fitter or master gas fitter to possess a license.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law provides an exception for persons performing work on their own residences.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and provides an additional exception for the following persons, for the limited purpose of installing generator gas lines:

- (1) A licensed electrical contractor who holds a statewide electrical work license classification.
- (2) A licensed mechanical contractor who holds a statewide mechanical work license classification.

The new exceptions provided for in <u>proposed law</u> apply only to the extent necessary to install generator gas lines.
