**Abstract:** Requires death certificate issuance within seven days after a request from the respective applicant.

<u>Present law</u> requires a funeral director or other individuals to initiate a death certificate and file it with the local registrar.

<u>Present law</u> allows changes to be made to the certificate under certain circumstances.

<u>Present law</u> allows the local registrar to send a death certificate to the state registrar on the 10<sup>th</sup> day after the certificate is filed with him.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires state registrar to issue a death certificate within seven days after a request from an authorized applicant pursuant to <u>present law</u>.
