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Abstract: Deems certain healthcare providers to meet credentialing requirements of the Medicaid managed care program by reason of their affiliation with a licensed hospital.

<u>Present law</u> establishes requirements and standards for credentialing by Medicaid managed care organizations of healthcare providers who furnish health services to persons enrolled in the Medicaid managed care program of this state. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Proposed law</u> stipulates that any healthcare provider who maintains hospital privileges or is a member of a hospital medical staff with a hospital licensed in accordance with <u>present law</u> shall be considered to have satisfied, and shall otherwise be exempt from having to satisfy, any credentialing requirements of a Medicaid managed care organization.
