Abstract: Excludes the adoption of certain provisions relative to grade marked lumber when adopting the latest edition of the International Residential Code as the State Uniform Construction Code.

<u>Present law</u> provides for the exclusion of certain provisions when adopting the latest edition of the International Residential Code as the State Uniform Construction Code.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> and adds an exclusion for those lumber standards provided for in Part III—Building Planning and Construction of the International Residential Code that require lumber to be stamped with the grade mark of a lumber grading or inspection agency.
