COURTS. Provides relative to the traffic violations bureau in certain city courts. (gov sig)

1 AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 13:1900(D), relative to traffic violations bureaus; to provide for
3 traffic violations bureaus in Ouachita Parish; to provide for an effective date; and to
4 provide for related matters.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 13:1900(D) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:

7 §1900. Traffic violations bureau

8 * * *

9 D. The provisions of this Section shall not apply to any city court in the
10 parishes of Acadia, Allen, Ascension, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Caddo, Calcasieu,
11 Concordia, East Baton Rouge, Evangeline, Franklin, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson,
12 Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, Lafourche, Lincoln, Livingston, Morehouse,
13 Natchitoches, ~~Ouachita~~, Rapides, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, St. Tammany,
14 Tangipahoa, Vermilion, Vernon, Washington, Webster, West Baton Rouge, Winn,
15 Pointe Coupee, East Feliciana, West Feliciana, East Carroll, Madison, St. James, Red
16 River, and Grant.

17 * * *

1 Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
2 signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
3 by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
4 vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
5 effective on the day following such approval.

Present law provides that the mayor of a municipality may establish, under his supervision, a traffic violations bureau and adopt the necessary rules and regulations for its operation and administration. Further provides that the mayor may assume responsibility for a municipality's existing violations bureau created pursuant to Act No. 32 of the 1960 R.S.

Proposed law retains present law.

Present law does not apply to any city court in the parishes of Acadia, Allen, Ascension, Avoyelles, Beauregard, Caddo, Calcasieu, Concordia, East Baton Rouge, Evangeline, Franklin, Iberia, Iberville, Jefferson, Jefferson Davis, Lafayette, Lafourche, Lincoln, Livingston, Morehouse, Natchitoches, Ouachita, Rapides, St. Landry, St. Martin, St. Mary, St. Tammany, Tangipahoa, Vermilion, Vernon, Washington, Webster, West Baton Rouge, Winn, Pointe Coupee, East Feliciana, West Feliciana, East Carroll, Madison, St. James, Red River, and Grant.

Proposed law removes Ouachita Parish.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
