## PUBLIC MEETINGS: Removes provision terminating authority of the State Bond Commission to hold periodic meetings via electronic means

## AN ACT To repeal R.S. 42:29(G), relative to public meetings; to provide relative to the authority of

3 the State Bond Commission to hold periodic meetings via electronic means.

4 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

5 Section 1. R.S. 42:29(G) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

HB 325 Original 2022 Regular Session Stefanski

Abstract: Repeals the termination provision for authority for the State Bond Commission to hold one meeting per quarter via electronic means.

<u>Present law</u> requires that meetings of public bodies be open to the public and prohibits a public body from utilizing any manner of proxy voting procedure, secret balloting, or any other means to circumvent the intent of <u>present law</u>. Requires that all votes made by members of a public body be viva voce and be recorded in the minutes, journal, or other official, written proceedings of the body. Provides exceptions.

<u>Present law</u> authorizes the State Bond Commission to hold periodic meetings via teleconference or video conference. Provides stipulations regarding such meetings. Limits the number of such meetings to one teleconference per quarter. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u>.

<u>Present law</u> provides for termination of <u>present law</u> on Aug. 1, 2022. <u>Proposed law</u> repeals <u>present law</u>.
