Abstract: Provides for the disclosure of required homeowners' association membership in the listing of a residential property. Requires the buyer be given a copy of homeowners' association covenants and governing documents.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 9:3198) provides for seller property disclosures, which include a statement of notification to the purchaser as to whether or not membership in a homeowners' association is required.

<u>Present law</u> (R.S. 9:3198) provides that the disclosure statement include information stating that covenants and association governing documents are a matter of public record and informs the purchaser on how such documents can be obtained.

Present law (R.S. 9:3198) defines "homeowners' association".

Present law (R.S. 9:3199) provides for duties of real estate licensees.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but provides that real estate licensees who are listing agents shall advertise homeowners' association membership requirements.

Present law (R.S. 37:1431) defines "listing agent".

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that the buyer shall be given a copy of homeowners' association covenants and governing documents prior to the execution of the sale of a property sold subject to homeowners' association membership.
