MEDICAL MARIJUANA: Provides relative to eligibility for a therapeutic use of marijuana production license

1 AN ACT

2 To repeal R.S. 40:1046(H)(7), relative to production facility licenses for the therapeutic use
3 of marijuana; to remove the disqualification of contributing to a candidate in a
4 Louisiana election as a condition for eligibility of a production license.

5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:

6 Section 1. R.S. 40:1046(H)(7) is hereby repealed in its entirety.

Abstract: Removes the disqualification of contributing to a candidate in a Louisiana election as a condition for eligibility to bid for a therapeutic use of marijuana production license.

Present law prohibits any company that has made a contribution to a candidate in a La. election governed by the provisions of the Campaign Finance Disclosure Act, or a company controlled wholly or in part by a person who made such a contribution, from obtaining a production license for therapeutic use of marijuana if the contribution was made within five years prior to bidding for the license.

Proposed law repeals present law.
