Abstract: Authorizes early learning centers to maintain a supply of auto-injectable epinephrine for emergency use.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires early learning centers to adopt a policy authorizing the emergency administration of auto-injectable epinephrine.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires early learning centers to provide all parents with a copy of this policy.

<u>Proposed law</u> further requires at least one employee to receive training from a licensed medical professional or state-approved training course in the administration of auto-injectable epinephrine.

<u>Proposed law</u> authorizes early learning centers to maintain a supply of auto-injectable epinephrine.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides liability protection for licensed early learning centers, employees of licensed early learning centers, licensed medical professionals who prescribe epinephrine auto-injectors to licensed early learning centers, and state-recognized anaphylaxis training organizations and their personnel.
