



office, or association who has expertise in transitional postsecondary educational services.

Proposed law requires the commissioner of higher education to convene the first meeting no later than September 1, 2022.

Proposed law requires the Board of Regents, with assistance from the council, to provide an annual report to the Senate committees on education and finance, the House committees on education and appropriations and to post the report on the board's website. Requires the report to include a detailed accounting of the fund, information for each program receiving a distribution from the fund, details on each technical assistance grant provided from the fund, and any recommendations for additional money for the fund.

Proposed law requires each public postsecondary education management board to report to the Board of Regents the information necessary for the Board of Regents to complete the report.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
