UNEMPLOYMENT COMP: Provides relative to the unemployment compensation weekly benefit amount

AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 23:1592(F), relative to unemployment compensation benefits; 3 to provide for an increase in the minimum weekly benefit amount; and to provide for 4 related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 23:1592(F) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 7 §1592. Weekly benefit amount 8 9 F. The weekly benefit amount pursuant to this Section to unemployed 10 individuals filing a new claim for benefits may be modified in accordance with the 11 provisions in R.S. 23:1474. In no event shall the weekly amount paid pursuant to 12 this Section be more than as designated in R.S. 23:1474 nor less than ten fifty 13 dollars. 14

Abstract: Provides for an increase in the minimum amount for the unemployment compensation weekly benefit amount.

<u>Present law</u> provides that the weekly benefit amount paid to unemployed individuals filing a new claim for benefits may be modified in accordance with <u>present law</u>. <u>Present law</u> further provides that the weekly benefit amount paid shall not be more than \$312 and not less than \$10.

<u>Proposed law</u> increases the minimum weekly benefit amount <u>from</u> \$10 to \$50. <u>Proposed law</u> otherwise retains <u>present law</u>.
