Luneau

<u>Present law</u> provides rules regarding licensure, qualifications, and exemptions for persons engaged in the practice of massage therapy.

<u>Present law</u> requires applicants for a massage therapist license to pay the application fee and submit evidence satisfactory to the La. Board of Massage Therapy that he or she has satisfactorily completed a minimum 500 hour in-class supervised course of studies pursuant to rules promulgated by the board in accordance with the Administrative Procedure Act.

<u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law</u> but requires that the minimum five hundred hours be supervised by an instructor. <u>Proposed law</u> further provides that hours above the required minimum 500 hours may be a combination of online and in-class hours.

Effective August 1, 2022.
