CRIME: Provides relative to the penalties for the crime of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle

AN ACT

2	To amend and reenact R.S. 14:68.4(B), relative to the crime of unauthorized use of a motor
3	vehicle; to provide relative to criminal penalties; and to provide for related matters.
4	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
5	Section 1. R.S. 14:68.4(B) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows:
6	§68.4. Unauthorized use of a motor vehicle
7	* * *
8	B.(1) Whoever commits the crime of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle
9	Upon a first conviction, the offender shall be fined not more than five thousand
10	dollars or imprisoned with or without hard labor for not more than two years, or
11	both.
12	(2) Upon a second conviction, the offender shall be imprisoned, with or
13	without hard labor, for not more than ten years, or may be fined not more than ten
14	thousand dollars, or both.
15	(3) Upon a third or subsequent conviction, the offender shall be imprisoned
16	at hard labor for not more than twenty years, or may be fined not more than fifty
17	thousand dollars, or both.

**Abstract:** Enhances the penalties for the crime of unauthorized use of a motor vehicle.

<u>Present law</u> provides that unauthorized use of a motor vehicle is the intentional taking or use of a motor vehicle which belongs to another without the intent to permanently deprive the other of the motor vehicle permanently.

<u>Present law</u> provides that an offender shall be fined not more than \$5,000, imprisoned with or without hard labor for not more than two years, or both.

<u>Proposed law</u> amends <u>present law</u> to enhance the penalties as follows:

- (1) First conviction, a fine of not more than \$5,000, imprisonment with or without hard labor for not more than two years, or both.
- (2) Second conviction, the offender shall be imprisoned, with or without hard labor, for not more than 10 years, or may be fined not more than \$10,000, or both.
- (3) Third or subsequent conviction, the offender shall be imprisoned at hard labor for not more than 20 years, or may be fined not more than \$50,000, or both.
