AN ACT

2 To amend and reenact R.S. 37:3506(A), relative to the state board of private investigators; 3 to adjust the salary limit for the executive director of the board; and to provide for 4 related matters. 5 Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana: 6 Section 1. R.S. 37:3506(A) is hereby amended and reenacted to read as follows: 7 §3506. Executive director; duties 8 A. The position of executive director of the board is hereby created. The 9 executive director shall be appointed by the board with consent of the governor and shall serve as the chief administrator of the board. He shall not be a member of the 10 11 board, but shall be a full-time unclassified employee of the board who shall be paid 12 compensation in an amount to be determined by the board which shall not exceed 13 fifty ninety thousand dollars annually. The office, equipment, and furnishings of the 14 board and the executive director shall be initially furnished by the Department of 15 Public Safety and Corrections. 16

**Abstract:** Adjusts the cap currently placed on the salary of the executive director of the board of private investigators.

<u>Present law</u> creates the position of executive director of the board of private investigators and provides for his appointment, full-time status, classification of employment, and manner of salary determination. <u>Proposed law</u> retains <u>present law.</u>

<u>Present law</u> places a \$50,000 maximum limit on the annual salary of the executive director. <u>Proposed law</u> adjusts the salary limitation <u>from</u> \$50,000 <u>to</u> \$90,000 annually.
