Abstract: Requires a health coverage plan to limit an enrollee's cost-sharing amount to \$25 for a 30-day prescription of insulin.

Proposed law defines "health coverage plan", "formulary", and "insulin".

<u>Proposed law</u> prohibits a health coverage plan from imposing a cost-sharing provision for insulin in the plan's formulary if the enrollee is required to pay more than \$25 per prescription for a 30-day supply, regardless of the amount or type of insulin needed to fill the enrollee's prescription.

<u>Proposed law</u> requires a health coverage plan to include at least one insulin from each therapeutic class in the plan's formulary.
