HOUSING. Abolishes the Louisiana Housing Corporation. (gov sig)

1	AN ACT
2	To repeal Chapter 3-G of Title 41, consisting of R.S. 40:600.86 through 40:600.111, relative
3	to the Louisiana Housing Corporation; to abolish the Louisiana Housing
4	Corporation; and to provide for related matters.
5	Be it enacted by the Legislature of Louisiana:
6	Section 1. R.S. 40:600.86 through 40:600.111 are hereby repealed.
7	Section 2. This Act shall become effective upon signature by the governor or, if not
8	signed by the governor, upon expiration of the time for bills to become law without signature
9	by the governor, as provided by Article III, Section 18 of the Constitution of Louisiana. If
10	vetoed by the governor and subsequently approved by the legislature, this Act shall become
11	effective on the day following such approval.
12	Section 3. If the instrument which originated as Senate Bill No. of the 2022 Regular
13	Session of the Legislature does not become effective, this Act shall be null and void and of
14	no effect.

<u>Present law</u> creates the Louisiana Housing Corporation and provides for its powers, duties, and functions.

<u>Proposed law</u> provides that <u>proposed law</u> shall be of no effect if the instrument which originated as Senate Bill No. \_ of the 2022 Regular Session does not become effective.

Effective upon signature of the governor or lapse of time for gubernatorial action.
